



WM1092 Dog's Crochet Cardigan



Designed by Sharon Mann.

Directions are for size small; changes for medium and large are in parentheses.

MODA DEA® "Tweedle Dee™": 2 (3, 3) Balls No. 8921 Ocean Breeze [shaded effect colors – 3.52 oz (100 g), 155 yd (142 m)].

Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10.5].
Yarn needle; 4 (5, 5) 3/4 (1, 1 1/4)" buttons.

GAUGE: 11 sts = 4"; Rows 1-13 = 4" in sc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

To Fit Chest: 18 (23, 28)".

To Fit Neck: 16 (18, 20)".

To Fit Length: 10 (12, 16)".

BACK-Ribbing (Beg at tail end): Ch 7 (8, 9).

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across; turn – 6 (7, 8) sc.

Rows 2-18 (2-26, 2-32): Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in **back lp** of each sc across; turn. At end of last row, turn to work across row ends.

Body-Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, work 20 (28, 34) sc evenly across row ends of ribbing; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

Shape Sides-Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc; 2 sc in last sc; turn – 22 (30, 36) sc.

Rows 4 and 5: Rep Row 2.

Row 6: Rep Row 3 – 24 (32, 38) sc.

Rows 7-9: Rep Row 2.

Row 10: Rep Row 3 – 26 (34, 40) sc.

Rows 11-14: Rep Rows 7-10 – 28 (36, 42) sc.

Rows 15-17: Rep Rows 4-6 – 30 (38, 44) sc.

Rows 18-20: Rep Rows 4-6 – 32 (40, 46) sc.

Rows 21-26 (21-28, 21-48): Rep Row 2.

Divide for Left Neck -Row 1 (Wrong Side): Ch 1, sc in first 7 (9, 11) sc; turn.

Rows 2-6 (2-8, 2-12): Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.

Buttonhole Row 7 (9, 13): Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, ch 1 (1, 2), skip next 1 (1, 2) sc, sc in next 1 (3, 3) sc, ch 1 (1, 2), skip next 1 (1, 2) sc, sc in last 2 sc; turn.

Row 8 (10, 14): Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, 1 (1, 2) sc in next sp, sc in next 1 (3, 3) sc, 1 (1, 2) sc in next sp, sc in last 2 sc. Fasten off.

Right Neck-Row 1: With wrong side facing, skip next 18 (22, 24) sc of last long row, join yarn in next sc; ch 1, sc in each sc to end; turn – 7 (9, 11) sc.

Rows 2-9 (2-11, 2-15): Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off. Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

COLLAR: Ch 4.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch; turn – 3 sc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in **back lp** of each sc across; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in back lp of first sc, sc in back lp of each sc across; turn – 4 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc across; turn.

Rows 6-13 (6-15, 6-19): Rep Rows 4 and 5 four (5, 7) more times – 8 (9, 11) sc.

Rows 14-31 (16-33, 20-37): Rep Row 5.

Row 32 (34, 38): Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in back lp of each sc across; turn – 7 (8, 10) sc.

Row 33 (35, 39): Rep Row 5.

Rep last 2 rows 4 (5, 7) more times – 3 sc. Work 3 rows even. Fasten off.

Collar Edging: With right side facing, join yarn and work 2 rows sc across the shaped edge of the collar. Fasten off. Sew the collar in place.

Sweater Edging: With right side facing, join yarn and work 2 rows sc from neck to tail, including ribbings. Rep on opposite side.

CHEST PANEL-Left Side Ribbing: Ch 7. Work in ribbing same as for Back across 6 sc for 12 (14, 16) rows. Turn, ch 1 and work 12 (14, 16) evenly across row ends. Work even in ribbing across these sts for 14 (18, 22) rows. Fasten off.

Right Side Ribbing with Buttonholes: Work same as Left Side Ribbing for 2 rows.

Buttonhole Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in back lp of next sc, ch 2, skip next 2 sc, sc in back lp of last 2 sc; turn.

Buttonhole Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in back lp of next sc, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, sc in back lp of last 2 sc; turn.

Work 4 (2, 4) rows even in ribbing. Rep Buttonhole Rows 1 and 2. Work 2 (2, 4) rows even in ribbing. Fasten off for Size Small.

Sizes Medium and Large: Rep Buttonholes 1 and 2. Work (2, 0) rows even in ribbing. Fasten off.

Sew Chest Panel pieces to right and left sides of Back as designated. Sew buttons in place. Weave in ends.
