



ACTION SCARF & HAT SET

Scarf



BEGINNER

Hat



EASY

Size

Scarf: One size

Hat: Child's medium (adult medium, adult large)

Finished Measurements

Scarf: 6" wide x 50" long (excluding fringe)

Hat: Circumference 17 (18½, 20½)"

Materials

- 2-1.75oz/50g balls (49yds/44m) ACTION in 70% acrylic, 30% wool in #1 Neutrals for **Scarf**
- 1 pair size 15 (10mm) needles for **Scarf**
- 2 (3, 3) -1.75oz/50g balls (49yds/44m) ACTION in 70% acrylic/30% wool in #1 Neutrals for **Hat**
- 1 pair size 13 (9 mm) needles for **Hat**
- Large-eyed blunt needle for weaving in ends
- Large crochet hook for working fringe

Gauges

Scarf: 9 stitches and 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).

Hat: 9 stitches and 14 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).

Scarf

Note: Cut fringe before you begin.

Cast on 14 stitches.

Knit 1 row (wrong side).

Knit 10 rows (5 ridges).

Knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Repeat last 2 rows twice—6 rows in stockinette stitch.

Repeat 16 rows for pattern stitch until scarf measures 50" from beginning, ending with knit 10 rows.

Bind off loosely.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 30 strands of yarn 15" long. With 3 strands of yarn in each fringe, work 5 fringes along each short end. Trim fringe.

Hat

Cast on 38 (42, 46) stitches.

Rib row 1 (right side) *Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from *, end knit 2.

Rib row 2 (wrong side) *Purl 2, knit 2; repeat from *, end purl 2.

Repeat last 2 rows until hat measures 4 (4½, 5½)" from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

Next row (right side) Knit all stitches.

Next row (wrong side) Purl all stitches.

Repeat last 2 rows until hat measures 8" from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

Decrease row 1 (right side) Knit 1 (1, 2), *knit 2 together, knit 4; repeat from * end, knit 1 (1, 2) stitches – 32 (35, 39) stitches.

Next row and all wrong side rows

Purl all stitches.

Decrease row 2 Knit 1 (1, 2), *knit 2 together, knit 3; repeat from * end, knit 1 (1, 2) – 26 (28, 32) stitches.

Decrease row 3 Knit 1 (1, 2), *knit 2 together, knit 2; repeat from * end, knit 1 (1, 2) – 20 (21, 25) stitches.

Decrease row 4 Knit 1 (1, 2), *knit 2 together, knit 1; repeat from * end, knit 1 (1, 2) – 14 (14, 18) stitches.

Decrease row 5 Knit 1 (1, 2), *knit 2 together; repeat from * end, knit 1 – 8 (7, 11) stitches.

Decrease row 6 for adults size large only *Knit 2 together; repeat from * knit 1 – 6 stitches.

Cut yarn leaving 4 or 5". Thread through a large-eyed needle and thread remaining stitches onto needle. Draw tightly and take needle into top of hat and weaving end into inside. Sew back hat seam, sewing turned up part of ribbing on opposite side so seam doesn't show when ribbing is turned up. Weave in ends.
