



ACTION BI-COLOR SCARF



BEGINNER

Size

One size

Finished Measurements

5" wide x 46" long (excluding fringe)

Materials

- 1-1.75oz/50g ball (49 yds/44 m) ACTION 70% acrylic/30% wool in color #2 Girly (A)
- 1 ball in color #3 Pastels (B)
- 1 pair size 15 (10mm) needles
- Large-eyed blunt needle for weaving in ends
- Large crochet hook for working fringe

Gauge

9 stitches and 12 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side).

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Scarf

Note: Cut fringe before you begin with half in color A and half in color B.

With color A, cast on 11 stitches. Knit 1 row (wrong side). Knit 10 rows (5 ridges). Knit 1 row, purl 1 row. Repeat last 2 rows twice—6 rows in stockinette stitch. Repeat 16 rows for pattern stitch until yarn is almost used up, ending with 2 ridges in pattern. Add color B and continue in pattern stitch with B until scarf measures 46" from beginning, ending with knit 10 rows.

Bind off loosely.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 30 strands of yarn 15" long. With 3 strands of yarn in each fringe, work 5 fringes along each short end. Trim fringe.
