A Patons soft shades blanket | KNIT



MATERIALS

Patons® Astra™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 161 yds/147 m) Hot Lilac (08317) **9 balls**

Sizes U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles 90 cm long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

<u>SIZES</u> Approx 32 x 38" [81.5 x 96.5 cm].

GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needle in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needle, cast on 179 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows: Work 5 rows garter st (knit every

row), noting that fir st row is WS and inc 8 sts evenly across last row. 187 sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows: **1st row:** (RS). K3. *SI1P. K4. Rep from * to last 4 sts. SI1P. K3. **2nd row:** Purl. **3rd and 4th rows:** As 1st and 2nd rows once more. **5th row:** As 1st row. **6th row:** K3. *P1. K4. Rep from * to last 4 sts. P1. K3. These 6 rows form check pat. Cont in check pat until Blanket from beg measures approx 37" [94 cm], ending on a 4th row of pat

and dec 8 sts evenly across last row. 179 sts.

Change to smaller needle and work 5 rows garter st. Cast off knitways (WS).

Side edgings: With RS of work facing and smaller needle pick up and knit 213 sts along each side edge. Work 6 rows garter st. Cast off knitwise (WS).

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
